I am requesting funding for the Cooper Chapel Road Extension and Construction project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government located at 601 W. Jefferson St., Louisville, KY 40202.

The Cooper Chapel Road Extension and Construction project will construct 2.8 miles of new two-lane roadway with a continuous center left-turn lane and 2.8 miles of new shared-use path in Louisville, Kentucky. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project will improve traffic flow and safety for drivers by adding a continuous left turn lane, while also supporting nonmotorized forms of transportation by creating a new 2.8 mile shared use path.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
