I am requesting funding for the Cooper Chapel Road Extension and Construction project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government located at 601 W. Jefferson St., Louisville, KY 40202.

The Cooper Chapel Road Extension and Construction project will construct 2.8 miles of new two-lane roadway with a continuous center left-turn lane and 2.8 miles of new shared-use path in Louisville, Kentucky.
