I am requesting funding for the Dixie Highway Sidewalk and Safety Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government located at 601 W. Jefferson St., Louisville, KY 40202.

The funding would be used for significantly enhancing pedestrian infrastructure and safety along three critical corridors in Louisville. This combined project spans approximately 4.8 miles and includes segments where Dixie Highway meets Crums Lane, Rockford/Lees Lane, and Valley Station/3rd Street Road. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve safety and accessibility, support connectivity to public transportation, and encourage active living.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b)(7).
