I am requesting funding for the Jefferson Rising Parking Lot Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Jefferson Community and Technical College (JCTC) located at 109 E. Broadway, Louisville, KY 40202.

The funding would be used for helping JCTC revitalize their downtown campus in the heart of Louisville, replacing a surface parking lot that improves accessibility, improves the quality of our downtown, and ensures JCTC's students - who are all commuters - can continue to pursue degrees on campus.
